Healthy, Resilient, and Sustainable Communities After Disasters identifies and recommends recovery practices and novel programs most likely to impact overall community public health and contribute to resiliency for future incidents. With six appendixes detailing the long-running diversionary musicals and a foreword by Sheldon Harnick, the lyricist of *Fiddler on the Roof*, Jones's comprehensive social history will appeal to both students and fans of Broadway.
