THE PANEL VIGOROUSLY REVIEWED ISSUES OF RESILIENT DEVELOPMENT AND FOOD SECURITY. THIS BOOK IS A PRODUCT OF THE OXFORD ENVIRONMENT CONFERENCE. IT TAKES THE ESSENTIAL QUESTIONS OF SUSTAINABILITY AS A STARTING POINT TO FOCUS ON PRESENT FOOD SECURITY AND ITS FUTURE PROSPECTS IN THE FACE OF CLIMATE CHANGE. WHY IS THIS BOOK IMPORTANT? THIRD, I BELIEVE CLIMATE CHANGE IS A SERIOUS THREAT AND I AM DISMAYED AT THE WAY NATIONS DITHER OVER HOW TO CONTROL GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS AND MECHANISMS TO MEET THE CHALLENGE OF ADVERSE CLIMATE IMPACTS.
