well in the siege of Mafeking and shows a clear lineage to the formation of the tenets of his formation of the Boy Scouts. Agency could be defined as “an actor’s or group’s ability to make purposeful choices – that is, the actor is able to envisage and purposefully choose options” (p. 11).
